If you are a resident of Massachusetts, you will need a designated home state (DHS) license to adjust insurance claims in a licensed state. Texas is a great designated home state (DHS) to consider! Once you have obtained your non-resident DHS adjuster license, you can apply for reciprocal licenses from other states.
